

**The Board of Governors of Grant MacEwan University (“MacEwan University”)
OVEN Passport Contest Rules and Regulations**

1. The “OVEN Passport” Contest (the “Contest”) runs March 6, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. (MST) until March 28, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. (MST) (the “Contest Entry Period”).
2. To be eligible to enter, a contestant must **1.)** Obtain the contest stamp card (the “Card”) from a cashier in Building 6, **2.)** Visit OVEN every Wednesday during the Contest Entry Period (excluding November 24, as it falls during MacEwan University’s Fall Reading Week break) and select the week’s international feature, **3.)** For each meal, collect the corresponding stamp on the Card, **4.)** Collect at least three (3) stamps to be eligible for one (1) ballot entry and **5.)** hand deliver the stamped card to a cashier in Building 6 prior to the expiry of the Contest Entry Period.
3. The odds of winning will be dependent on the number of eligible ballots received after the Contest Entry Period.
4. There will be a total of one (1) prize (the “Prize”) of a \$250 (CDN) campus dining card (to be used at MacEwan University Food Services vendors, including OVEN, SEASON, TASTE, Campus Convenience, Tavolino, Starbucks, Express, Subway and more). The prize winner will be selected by random draw from all entries received during the Contest Entry Period. The draw will be held on March 28, 2019 at approximately 12:00 p.m. (noon) at MacEwan University, Edmonton, Alberta. All winners will be notified by electronic means within two (2) days following the end of the Contest Entry Period. All winners will be notified by electronic means within two (2) days following the end of the Contest Entry Period. Should MacEwan University be unable to reach any winner in that time period for any reason, if any winner should fail to provide proof of contest eligibility, or if any winner should fail to make arrangements pick up the prize in a reasonable period of time then MacEwan University, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to select a new winner for that prize. MacEwan University shall be released and discharged from any liability or responsibility to this regard.
5. All entries are subject to verification and will be declared invalid if they are illegible, damaged, incomplete, forged, falsified, altered or tampered with in any way. MacEwan University shall not be responsible for any errors or omissions in printing or advertising this Contest.
6. The Contest is open to all persons who are 13 years of age or older, except:
 - a. Any person who on or after March 6, 2019, was or is a Food Services employee of MacEwan University; or
 - b. Any person who is an immediate family member (defined as spouse, dependent for federal income tax purposes, half-sister, half-brother, or step-, biological, foster, in-law or adoptive mother, father, sister, brother, daughter or son) of, or who resides or is domiciled in the same household as, any person in the preceding category.

7. By entering the Contest, each entrant accepts these Contest Rules and Regulations, which are subject to change without notice to Contest entrants. All entrants must comply with these Contest Rules and Regulations, and each entrant will be deemed to have received and understood these Contest Rules and Regulations by entering the Contest.
8. By entering the Contest, each entrant releases MacEwan University and any other person or entity associated in any way with the Contest, and all of their respective affiliates, subsidiaries, directors, officers, shareholders, owners, partners, employees, agents and their respective advertising and promotional agencies from any and all liability or claims arising in connection with the Contest, including, without limitation, as may relate to the selection of the prize winners and the administration of the Contest.
9. MacEwan University reserves the right to terminate, close or suspend the Contest for any reason at any time during the Contest Entry Period or otherwise, in its sole and absolute discretion and without prior notice and without incurring any liability whatsoever to entrants.
10. Any dispute relating to the Contest (including, without limitation, a dispute as to whether an entrant has complied with all of the Contest Rules and Regulations) shall be resolved by MacEwan University in its sole and absolute discretion, and the decision of MacEwan University shall prevail. All decisions of MacEwan University shall be final. Grant MacEwan University reserves the right to terminate, close or suspend the Contest for any reason at any time during the Contest Entry Period, in their sole and absolute discretion and without prior notice.
11. The Contest is void where prohibited by law and is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations.
12. The Contest and the terms and conditions contained in these Contest Rules and Regulations shall be governed exclusively by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Alberta and the federal laws of Canada applicable therein. Any dispute arising hereunder shall be adjudicated solely in the applicable court in Edmonton, Alberta.
13. Any personal information, as that term is defined in the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (“FOIP Act”), collected by MacEwan University as part of the Contest is collected pursuant to section 33(c) of the FOIP Act and will be used for purposes of the Contest.
